

Yearly Summer Programs

The following links are NOT a comprehensive list of various summer programs available; many programs will appear advertised under the Guidance Announcements on the main Guidance webpage. However, the following are special programs that Conner students participate in on a regular basis. Information can be gathered either through the websites listed or by contacting the Guidance office.

- Kentucky Governor's Scholars Program – www.kygsp.org – Students apply during the Junior Year to participate in the summer prior to Senior Year
- Kentucky Governor's School for the Arts – www.kentuckygsa.com – Students can apply during Sophomore Year or Junior year to participate during the summer – students can participate in architecture, creative writing, dance, drama, instrumental music, musical theatre, new media, visual art, or vocal music
- The Carol Martin Gatton Academy for Mathematics and Sciences in Kentucky – www.wku.edu/academy -- Sixty students are selected statewide to participate in the program at Western Kentucky University for their Junior and Senior years of high school. Students finish with their high school diplomas as well as sixty credit hours of college work. Conner has had six graduates from this program.
- Washington Youth Tour – www.owenelectric.com – “The Washington Youth Tour is an annual week-long event in June during which about 1,000 high school juniors from across the country travel to Washington DC to learn more about government, cooperatives, and electrification.”
